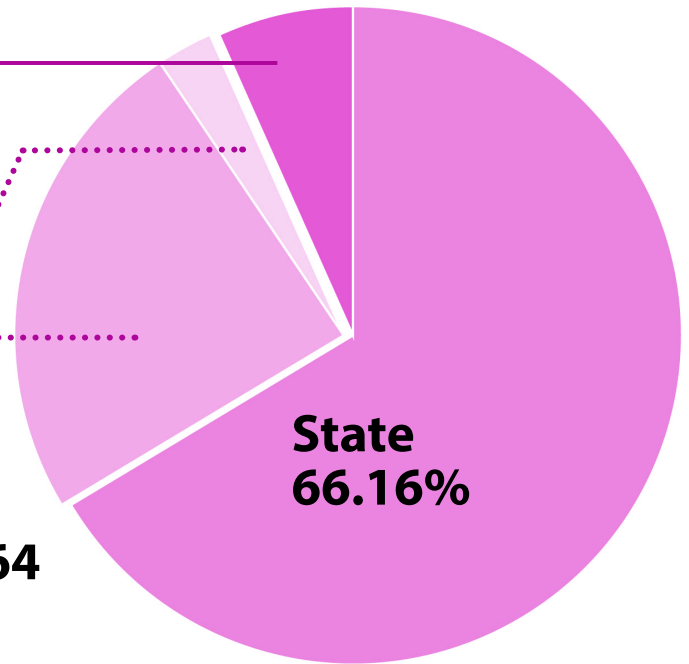

## Expenditures by Function

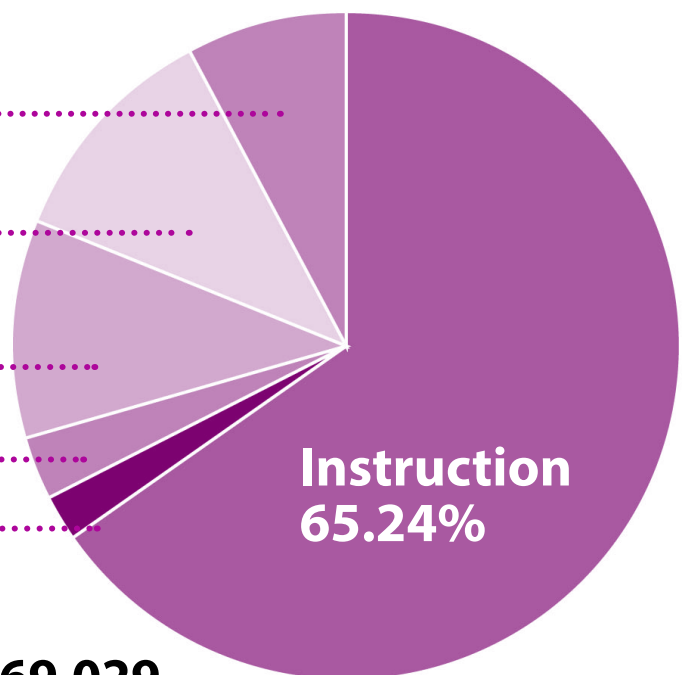
