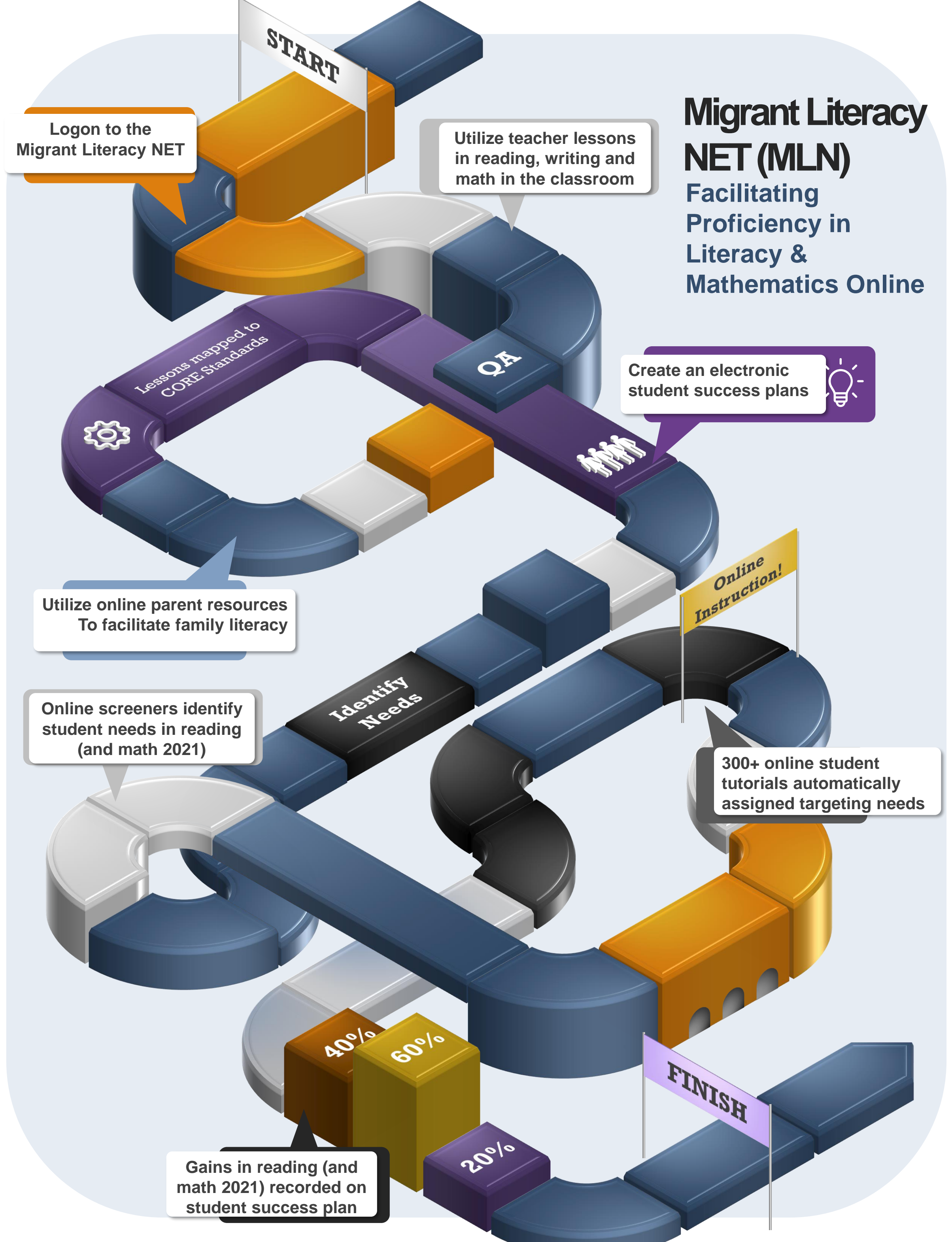

Teacher Resources

- **All lessons are mapped to both Common CORE standards and WIDA standards**

- **Reading, writing (and math activities in 2021) for parents to assist their children (in English and Spanish)**
