

# School Community Council Election Information

2023-2024

## Notice of Election

- An election is required, including notice of when and where to vote, and instructions for a parent to be added to the ballot

## Council Membership

- A council must have a 2-parent majority
- A defined number of school employee and parent seats with staggered terms must be listed in the Rules of Order and Procedure and filled in an election.
- Unless otherwise specified in Rules of Order & Procedure and approved by an SCC prior to elections, council membership is:
  - 4 parent members, and 2 school employee members (including principal) for an elementary or middle/jr. high school
  - 6 parent members, and 4 school employee members (including principal) for a high school

## Voting & Appointments

- Voting is required unless the number of applications does not exceed the number of open positions
- When positions remain open after elections:
  - existing parent members appoint parent members
  - existing school employees appoint school employee members
