MOTION was made by Member L. Cummins and seconded that the Procedures be amended to add language to Steps 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4 to acknowledge receipt of the concern or complaint within three days and meet and respond within ten days of the initial receipt of the concern or complaint.

MOTION to amend the amendment was made by Member Cannon and seconded to remove the words, "and meet."

Amendment to the amendment carried, with Members Boulter, Cannon, B. Cummins, Davis, Earl, Graviet, L. Hansen, S. Hansen, Huntsman, Lear and Newell in favor, and Members Belnap and L. Cummins opposed; Member Ellis absent.

Amendment, as amended, carried; Member Ellis absent.

MOTION was made by Member S. Hansen and seconded that 4.3 be amended to strike the words "employee" and "up to and including termination," to read: "Retaliation by USDB toward a parent for reporting concerns or complaints is strictly prohibited and may result in discipline."

Amendment carried unanimously.

Motion, as amended, carried, with Member Belnap opposed.

Superintendent Coleman introduced Karen Borg, Director of the Blind PIP Program, who is representing Associate Superintendent Carolyn Lasater. Associate Superintendents Lasater and Michelle Tanner were excused.

Superintendent Coleman reported on the following items:

Response to USDB Advisory Council Recommendations

USDB is proceeding with the recommendations from the Advisory Council regarding the toddler group and are piloting the new time structure for the group. The Advisory Council is aware of parent concerns with the new structure.

Annual Spring Planning Process

USDB staff have been engaging in the annual budgeting process which is nearing a close. The Enrichment Fund recommendations will go to the Advisory Council for review in its next meeting, and those recommendations and the budget will be brought to the Board for approval.
