

## STATE AGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW SUMMARY

Finding details:

Daily and weekly quantity requirements not met due to crediting error. Incomplete meals observed on Day of Review. Milk variety not offered throughout serving period on Day of Review. Menu signage is missing or does not meet requirements. At least one school is not properly implementing Offer vs. Serve. Day of Review portion sizes insufficient. Age/grade group meal pattern requirements not being met for multiple menus and/or multiple age/grade groups served. Family Style meal service not implemented properly for Pre-K students.
