STATE AGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW SUMMARY

Section 207 of the HHFKA amended section 22 of the NSLA (42 U.S.C. 1769c) to require state agencies to report the final results of the Administrative Review to the public in an accessible, easily understood manner in accordance with guidelines promulgated by the Secretary. Regulations at 7 CFR 210.18(m) requires the state agency to post a summary of the most recent final Administrative Review results for each School Food Authority (SFA) on the state agency's publicly available website no later than 30 days after the state agency provides the final results of the Administrative Review to the SFA. The state agency must also make a copy of the final Administrative Review report available to the public upon request.
