

STATE AGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW SUMMARY

Confirmation review not conducted at proper point in verification process. Verification notification letter does not contain all required information. Notice of adverse action did not contain all required information. Eligibility status not updated after Verification results determined.

Meal counts exceeded number of free, reduced price and/or paid eligible students. Meal counts by category not used correctly in the SFA's claim for reimbursement.
