<b>#1 Nationwide Mealtime Waiver</b> : Support SFAs to provide access to nutritious meals while minimizing potential exposure to the novel coronavirus. Applies to NSBP, NSLP, CACFP, SFSP. <b>#2 Non-Congregate Meal Waivers</b> : FNS has approved waivers for Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and National School Lunch Program Seamless Summer Option (SSO) sponsors to serve meals in a non-congregate setting and at school sites during school closures related to the coronavirus. Applies to NSBP, NSLP, CACFP, SFSP, SSO. FNS also issued guidance on <u>meal delivery using existing authorities in summer meal programs</u> . Applies to NSLP Afterschool Snack Program and CACFP At- Risk Afterschool Meals Program. #4 Nationwide Meal Pattern Waiver: States may locally waive specific meal pattern requirements as needed to support access to nutritious meals. When certain foods are not available due to the novel coronavirus. <b>#5 Nationwide Parent/Guardian Meal Pickup</b> <b>Waiver:</b> SFAs approved for non-congregate feeding can be approved to distribute meals to parents and guardians to take home for their children, as long as they protect accountability and integrity of the program. Applies to NSBP, NSLP, SSO, CACFP, SFSP. This also applies to guardians picking up meals for adult participants in CACFP Adult Day Care Programs.
