4. Complete SkillsUSA New Advisor Training. Date
5. Demonstrate to the satisfaction of the USBE's CTE Specialist that you have both the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively teach students all of the competencies outlined in the strands & standards for the courses authorized by this endorsement.
