Can serve and feed themselves

Walks a straight line forward and backward

Counts out loud to ten

Shares and takes turns with others

Listens to and talks about stories

Uses toilet and washes hands on their own

Balances on one foot for ten seconds

Counts objects by touching one at a time

Knows their first and last name and can tell an adult

Speaks clearly and is understood

Uses zippers, buttons, and ties on clothes

Hops, jumps, walks, runs



Knows parent's or guardian's first and last names

Recognizes and plays with rhyming words

Uses pencils, crayons, and scissors correctly

Bounces, catches, kicks, and throws balls

Sorts similar items into groups or pairs

Separates from caregiver easily

Knows letters in the alphabet have specific sounds

Turns book pages carefully

Makes and follows a plan to accomplish a task

Identifies, names, and creates basic shapes

Waits and listens while others talk, then responds

Draws pictures and talks about them
