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BUILD

- Build a strong and trusting relationship with the principal
- Build diverse and representative community school council

ASSESS

- Analyze school level data
- Conduct Root Cause(s) Analysis
- Dig deeper into root causes by assessing the community's needs and strengths
- Create an asset map

PLAN

- Lead the creation of a comprehensive community school action plan
- Be sure that your plan includes measures for outcomes and indicators

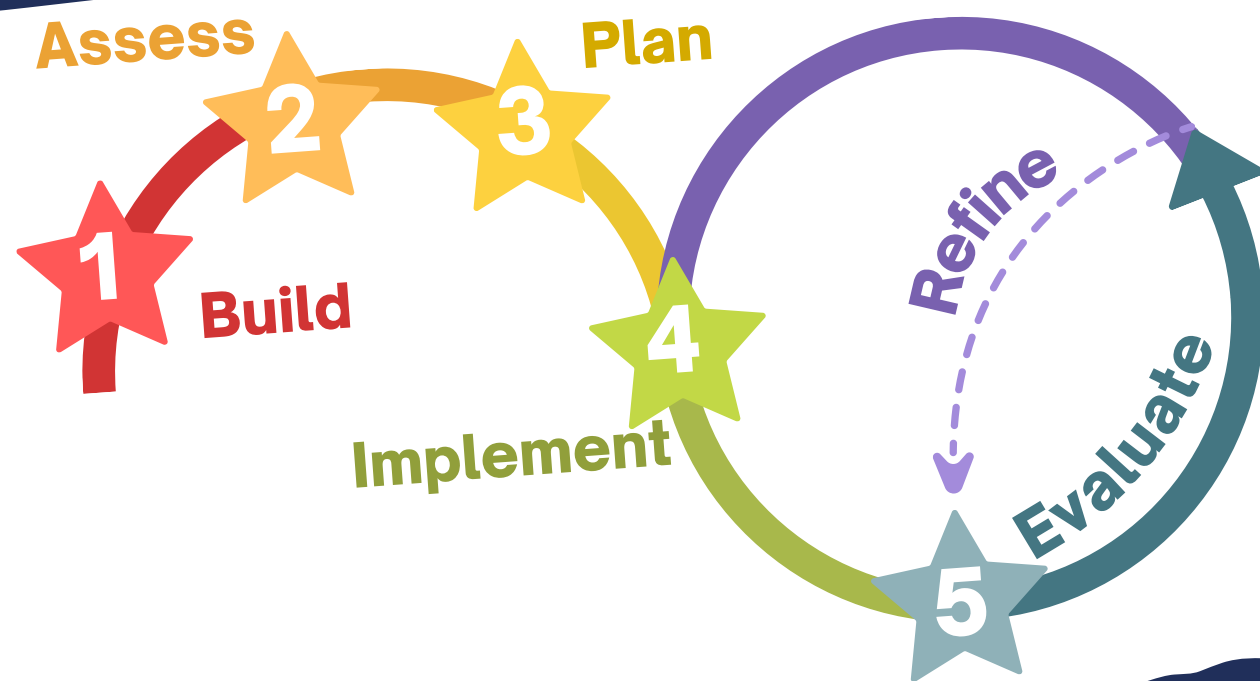


IMPLEMENT

- Implement the community school action plan
- Align the plan to overall school goals (90-day plan)
- Identify braided and blended funding to support your plan

EVALUATE

- The CS Council analyzes the plan's implementation
- Measure how much they did, how well they did it (effort) & is anyone better off (effect)
- Refine & Revise



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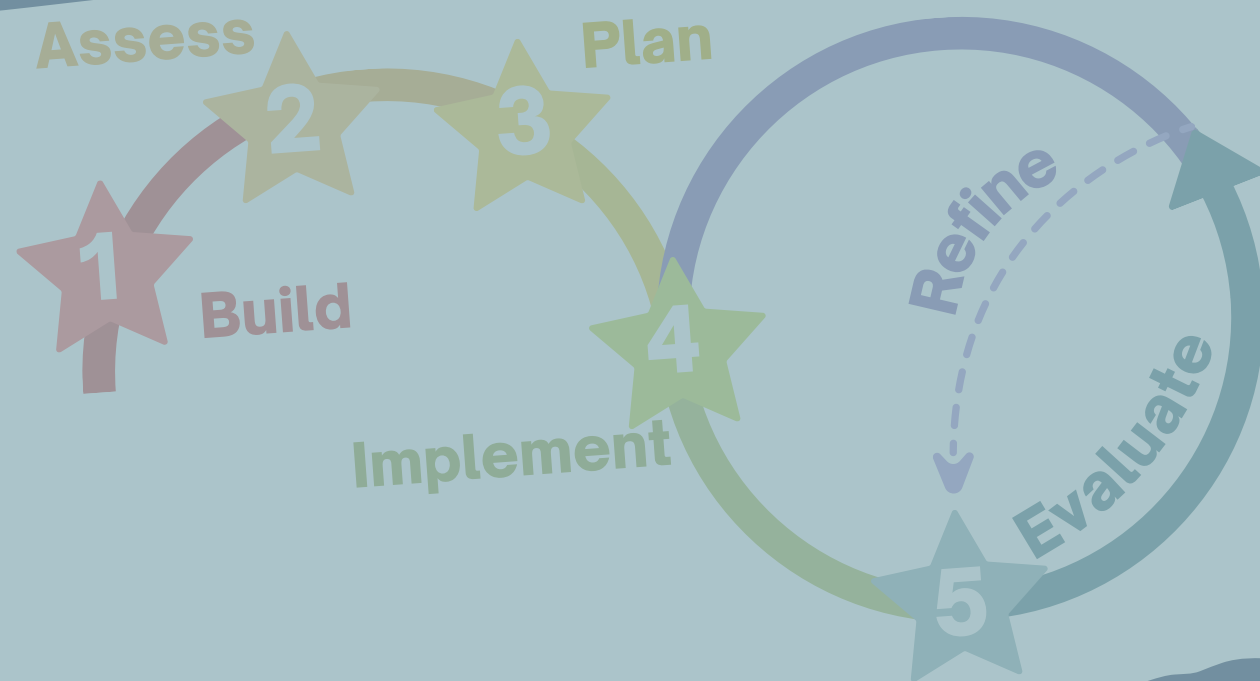
