Determine your purpose:

Establish a shared vision, desired outcomes for children and families, and how the partnership/programming will operate to accomplish these goals.

Develop an action plan, building on research and best practice and adapting for local context and community needs.

Evaluate the results: Continuous improvement is key! Plan, implement, study, make modifications - repeat! Gather feedback from end users, such as caregivers.

Celebrate successes to maintain momentum, small wins count!

Identify local champions for children and bring key stakeholders

together: identify a lead to coordinate communication and keep the work moving. Ensure diverse cross-sector representation with key decision makers.

Conduct a community

assessment to determine resources, needs and gaps, capture voices of families and community.

Implement your plans:

assign clear responsibilities, maintain communication throughout and continuously foster positive relationships.
