Initial Discussion Prompts for LEA and School Leaders

RAR Discussion Prompts – Initial

- 1.1. Describe your understanding or perspective of equitable allocation of resources.
- 1.2. A) **LEA Level** Describe the LEA resource allocation process/method to:
 - address identified needs or address achievement and opportunity gaps,
 - achieve the LEA goals and priorities,
 - support departments, programs, and schools.
 - B) **School Level** Describe the school-level resource allocation process/method to implement the school plan.
- 1.3. Describe the LEA and/or school process to monitor progress to ensure student outcomes are improving from an equitable standpoint.

Supplemental Discussion Prompts for LEA and School Leaders

RAR Discussion Prompts – Student and Teacher/Staff Needs

- 2.1. Describe how the LEA/school identifies needs for all students.
- 2.2. Describe how the LEA/school identifies needs for each student group.
 - Describe what data you use to identify needs for each student group.
 - Describe how you identify student groups to create learning opportunities and support for students.
- 2.3. Describe how the LEA/school identifies needs for:
 - all teachers and school leaders.
 - each subset of teachers and school leaders.



RAR Discussion Prompts – Programs and Services

- 3.1. Describe how the LEA/school selects and implements evidence-based strategies to support the needs of all students and student groups.
 - Describe how student data is used to evaluate program services and program effectiveness.
- 3.2. Describe how staff are made aware of improvement strategies.
 - Describe how ongoing, job-embedded professional learning aligns to improvement strategies.
 - Describe how implementation is monitored.
 - Describe how staff are measuring impact.
- 3.3. Describe how training or professional development is coordinated across systems of support to address site and student needs.
 - Describe systems of supervision.
 - Describe how PLCs are used to support implementation of professional development.

RAR Discussion Prompts – Funding and Resource Allocation

- 4.1. Describe the extent in which LEA or school leaders are involved in the budget and planning process.
 - Describe the relationship between the business administrators and the LEA/school leaders.
 - Describe the planning process for your alternative schools, your Title funds, etc.?
 - Describe how LEA leadership, departments, and school leaders are involved in the budget, planning and resource allocation process.
- 4.2. Describe how needs identified at school-level inform the LEA/school resource allocation methods.
- 4.3. Describe the comfort level of distributing funds equitably versus equally.
 - Describe the comfort level and use of blending and braiding funds.
 - Describe any promising practices you are using to blend or braid funds.

RAR Discussion Prompts – School-Level Specific

5.1. Describe the process the school improvement team engages in to review qualitative and quantitative data to determine identified needs.



- 5.2. Describe how the school improvement team ensures alignment between supplemental actions or services in the school improvement plan with identified needs.
- 5.3. Describe the process for requesting additional support from the district, beyond traditional site allocations.

Other Potential Discussion Prompts for LEA and School Leaders

RAR Discussion Prompts – Other

- 6.1. Describe any successes and barriers you have experienced in hiring, retaining diverse educators and leaders.
- 6.2. Describe how the LEA matches principal candidate competencies with schools' priorities and needs.
- 6.3. Describe the LEA's role in supporting principals to help mitigate potential burn out.
- 6.4. Describe how teachers and school administrators are empowered to develop an accurate understanding of poverty (conditions for equitable learning and development).
- 6.5. Describe opportunities teachers have to increase their expertise and repertoire in evidence-based practices.
- 6.6. Describe how you ensure low-income and minority students are taught by experienced and effective teachers at the same rate, or higher, as other students.
