

# 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) Grant – New Application Review Discussion

## Background Information

- Federally-Funded Competitive Grant Program
    - Title IV, Part B of the ESEA, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) (20 U.S.C. 7171-7176)
  - Opportunity for Local Education Agencies (LEAs), community and faith-based organizations to serve students and their families attending schools with poverty levels of **40 percent** or higher outside of regular school hours
- An out-of-school-time program that:
- Provides opportunities for academic enrichment to meet State and local student performance standards in core academic subjects such as reading and mathematics
  - Offers students a broad array of additional services that are designed to reinforce and complement the regular academic program of participating students
  - Offer families of students served by community learning centers opportunities for literacy and related educational development

## Grant Requirements

- Commits to 5 year grant cycles
- Minimum grants of \$100,000
- Grant reduces to 75% in Year 4
- Grant reduces to 50% in Year 5
- Level of service must be maintained at initial level

## Upcoming Grant Competition

- New funding available for eligible LEAs, community and faith-based organizations for 2018-2019 School Year
  - Expected Release Timeline - Summer 2018
- ESTIMATE for 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC funding for Utah as of June 6, 2018**
  - \$6,560,484**
    - \$2,816,259 – 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Continuation Grants**
    - ~\$3,200,000 – 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC New Grants**

## Adjustments to 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Grant Application

- Priority Points (additional points)
  - Clarify points and number of proposed program sites
  - Add Healthy Snack
  - Add Turnaround School
  - Add Rural County
  - Add Intergenerational Poverty (IGP) SchoolRate
- Application
  - Program Evaluation – update federal reporting system and quality assessment tool
  - Budget – add Budget Narrative Form
  - Private School Consultation – align with ESSA
  - STEM – add STEAM
