



TRANSFORM General Education

Certificate/Letter of Completion

(Awarded from USHE degree-granting institutuions)

General Education Core Requirements (minimun of 12 credits):

- Written Communication (3 6 credits):
 - ENGL 1010 or ENGL 2010
- Quantitative Literacy (3-4 credits):
 - MATH 1030, MATH/STAT 1040, or MATH 1050
- American Institutions (3-6 credits):
 - ECON 1740, HIST 1700, HIST 2700/2710, or POLS 1100

-USHE "Oppportunity Scholarship" available - check requirements for details

TRANSFORM CTE Education Institutional Credential

- Includes the award of an institutional credential for up to 900 hours or 30 credit hours
- Possible technical college scholarship opportunities

DISCOVERGeneral Education*

Complete one 3-credit approved breadth course in each of the following categories through concurrent enrollment:

- · Arts (3 credits)
- · Humanities (3 credits)
- · Life Sciences (3 credits)
- Physical Sciences (3 credits)
- · Social and Behavioral Sciences (3 credits)
