National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification

Funding Qualifications

In the 2016 General Session, House Bill 331 was passed to include financial provisions for Utah teachers who hold certification from the [National Board for Professional Teaching Standards](#). The legislative code can be reviewed at <http://le.utah.gov/~2016/bills/static/HB0331.html>.

Bonus Options:

There are 2 settings to receive the National Board Certification Bonuses:

Setting One: Teachers who hold a current **National Board of Professional Teaching Standards Certification** can receive up to \$750.00 each school year, **with an assignment to teach** in the classroom.

Setting Two: Teachers who hold a current **National Board Certification** **and an assignment to teach in the classroom** in a **Title 1 School** in Utah, can receive up to \$1,500.00 each school year.

Teachers interested in the National Board Certification Bonus are required to create an account in the [Teacher Salary Supplement Program Service Site](#), then submit an application each school year in which they wish to receive the bonus.

Approval of the National Board for Professional Teaching Standard certification bonus is subject to employment verification in CACTUS by the LEA and the Utah State Board of Education's Teacher Salary Supplement Program Specialist under authority of the State Superintendent.

The program does not include other nationally recognized certifications.
