



Young Technology Scholar Award Application

Micro Focus and the Utah State Board of Education (USB E) are pleased to sponsor the annual Young Technology Scholar (YTS) Award. This award is granted to high school seniors who have demonstrated proficiency in computer/IT related courses and leadership abilities in their schools and communities.

Winners can receive a scholarship award of up to \$5,000. Winners are selected by the YTS Scholarship Committee, which consists of representatives from Micro Focus and the Utah State Board of Education.

All applicants must be high school seniors who have taken, or are currently taking, the Micro Focus or Linux courses and who have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0. To apply for the Young Technology Scholar Award, students are required to submit the following:

- YTS application with student photo
- Two teacher/instructor recommendations
- R sum 
- Academic transcript
- Essay of 1,000 words or less on the topic, "How a Micro Focus/SUSE certification will help me achieve my future goals."
- Copy of your Micro Focus or SUSE certification, CompTIA Linux+ certification, or score report if completed. A Micro Focus or SUSE Linux certification, or Linux+ certification is not required to apply for this scholarship, but proof of certification must be submitted to USB E prior to receiving any scholarship monies if the applicant is selected.
- Signed Media Release form

Applications must be postmarked by **March 31** each year.
