## Tuition Awards – Institution Criteria

### Bridgerland Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Recipients are expected to begin training at Bridgerland Technical College within one year of graduation from high school. Scholarships commonly may be held for a later start date for students who wish to serve church missions or who may be involved in military service within that year following graduation and would like to begin training immediately following their service. These students must contact the Financial Aid Office within one year of high school graduation to notify the College of their plans and have the date the student must begin using the scholarship determined.
- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

The scholarship waives tuition up to \$1,000. Recipient is responsible for any tuition changes beyond the scope of this scholarship, to pay all fees; to purchase own books, tools and supplies; and for payment of any other cost associated with enrollment.
- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Yes. Bridgerland is open-entry and programs are taught year-round. Recipient must begin training within one year of high school graduation and tuition may be waived from that time up to \$1,000. Recipient must adhere to policies and procedures outlined for scholarship recipients available on the college's website; [www.btech.edu](http://www.btech.edu)
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

Many of Bridgerland's certificate programs qualify for this scholarship. Access the Scholarship Eligible Programs list on our school website: <http://btech.edu/students/financial-aid/scholarships/>
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

This scholarship is not available for renewal or extension. However, other scholarships and sources of financial aid are available, and students are encouraged to apply. Current opportunities are posted online at [www.btech.edu](http://www.btech.edu)
- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Bridgerland does not rank new students as freshman. Bridgerland offers competency-based training in a generally open-entry/open exit individualized learning and teaching model. Admissions for the CTE scholarship recipient are the same for all students in a particular program. ## Davis Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

The CTE scholarship is not deferrable.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

The scholarship waives tuition and student fees up to \$1,500. Recipient is responsible for program fees and any books and supplies.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Davis Tech is an open enrollment institution. This scholarship is valid for the fiscal year July 1, 2019-June 30, 2020.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

Math only and continuing education courses are not eligible.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

CTE scholarships are not renewable, however, other scholarships are available.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Admission requirements vary by program. Students must maintain at least a half-time schedule.

## Dixie Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Submit a letter of request for deferral to the Vice President of Student Services explaining the reason for the deferral and the length of deferral. This will be reviewed by the Vice President of Student Services for a final determination.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Full-Tuition

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

A student may access the scholarship during the summer if a program starts in the summer. Program start dates vary.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

All certificate programs are available for recipients.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

The scholarship is valid through the completion of the program.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Open Admission to the college, admission requirements vary by program.

### Mountainland Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

None

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Tuition only

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Yes

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

None

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

### Ogden Weber Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Students must activate the scholarship by October 31 of the year they graduate. No deferment available.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Scholarships are good for one year or \$1,800 – whichever is exhausted first.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Since Ogden Weber Technical College is open-enrollment, the student can use the scholarship in the summer.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

Programs that are less than 300 hours such as Real Estate, Driver Education, Math-only classes, Certified Nursing Assistant, Clinical Lab Assistant.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No. However, other financial aid assistance may be available. For more information, the student should contact the Financial Aid Office.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

The student cannot accept both the CTE Scholarship and the institution's Presidential Scholarship. If after using the \$1,800 CTE award (or one year), the student could apply for an adult need or achievement-based scholarship.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Every program has a testing level the student must pass.

### Southwest Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Up to 2 years, contact us by October 1, 2019

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Full tuition up to \$1,000.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Students may start at any time.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

No.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

Students may use until depleted, then may/should apply for other scholarships.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

None.

### Tooele Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Students need to enroll within one year following their graduation.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

\$500 towards tuition and fees.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

TTECH is open year-round. Students can enroll at any time.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

All programs are eligible for this scholarship.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No, non-renewable.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

### Uintah Basin Technical College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

UBTech will defer the scholarship for two years to accommodate volunteer or missionary work.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

The scholarship will be a full-tuition scholarship for one calendar year.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Yes. Our programs are open entry/open exit. Students can start at any time.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

CDL Truck Driving Training and POST Academy.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

The student can apply for additional scholarship to assist with fees and books as applicable. UBTech scholarship's will not over/double award tuition or fees. Students will not be able to collect overage.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Admission criteria depends on the program. UBTech does not look at incoming GPA. Students test for their program at the college or by assessing ACT scores (most programs require and ACT of 14 or better).

### Dixie State University

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Scholarship non-deferrable.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Full base tuition; does not cover fees, differential tuition, and is not able to exceed full tuition

when used in conjunction with any other DSU scholarships.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

No. Fall/Spring only.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

ESL, Communication Organizational Leadership, Degree completion programs, Institute for Continued Learning, Police Officer Standards Training, and Road Scholars Courses.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No. It is not renewable.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes, however, the combination cannot exceed full base instate tuition.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

Open admission, students must remain full-time enrollment and a 2.0 GPA.

### **Salt Lake Community College**

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

We typically do not defer scholarships because we are only a two-year institution. For students applying to our own internal SLCC scholarships, we typically have them re-apply as new students when they are getting ready to return.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

These recipients will be offered tuition waivers, meaning only tuition will be covered. Students are responsible to pay their own student/course fees. We do not have an exact dollar amount as of yet because tuition rates for the 2019-20 year have not been established. However, the amount for the 2018-19 year is \$1,684.50 per semester, or \$3,369.00 for the year.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

No

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No, but they would be welcome to apply for other SLCC scholarships/tuition waivers at <http://www.slcc.edu/scholarships/>.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

It would depend on what the other scholarship covers. Students cannot have more than one scholarship that covers the same thing. For example, if they both cover tuition, the student would

have to pick which one they would like to receive. They can't have both.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

None

### Snow College

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

Students are permitted to defer academic scholarships if it pertains to a military/medical/mission service. Any other scholarship that does not fit into this category may not be deferrable.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Two students will be offered a scholarship for \$1,000 each.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

The CTE scholarship is made available for student to use for fall and spring. If a student decides to enroll for the spring time (i.e. returning from a mission/military/medical/late enrollment), then he/she will be able to use it for spring and the following fall.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

It is applicable for CTE students.

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

No. A student in good standing can apply and benefit from possible additional scholarship opportunities provided at Snow College. We also help our students to apply for outside scholarship opportunities.

- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**

Yes.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

We are an inclusive college that provides open enrollment to our student population. Admitted students must have graduated with a high school diploma and have taken the ACT/SAT exam.

### Southern Utah University

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

The scholarship can be deferred for up to 6 semesters.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

Full-tuition one-year award.

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

No

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

N/A

- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**

Not for the first year but could after scholarship expires.

Students must have a minimum of a 90-index score.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

\$1,000 tuition waiver (\$500 for two semesters).

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

Can be used for summer, fall or spring tuition, but only for two semesters totaling (\$1,000).

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**

### **Utah State University Eastern, Price**

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

They need to complete the LOA process at <https://www.usu.edu/sots/loa>. Students may not attend another institution during deferment.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**

No. \$2,000 (\$1,000 per semester for 2 semesters).

- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

No.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**  
No.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**  
No, but they can apply for returning student scholarships if they have passed 30 credit hours.
- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**  
Yes.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**  
N/A open enrollment.

### **Utah State University, Moab**

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**  
Student must complete a leave of absence form for USU Moab.
- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**  
The scholarship is \$1,000 for a semester with a renewal of one additional semester.
- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**  
Yes.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**  
The scholarship is awarded for any CTE or STEM based certificate or degree.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**  
No, the scholarship is available for one year only (2 semesters).
- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**  
Yes
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**  
A student must submit ACT test scores, high school transcript and have a 2.33 GPA to apply.

### **Utah Valley University**

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**  
Students may defer for up to 2 years by completing a Request to Hold Form and providing documentation.
- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**  
Award amount is \$1,000 per semester for two semesters.
- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**

No, the scholarship is for Fall and Spring Semesters only.

- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**  
Global Aviation, ELL and Off Budget Courses.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**  
No, it is a one-year non-renewable award.
- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**  
Yes, they can receive up to full tuition.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**  
It is open admissions, but student must complete ACT/SAT.

### **Weber State University**

- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**  
Students may defer for public service or military service.
- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?**  
The scholarships are for \$2,000. To be distributed \$1,000 for fall and \$1,000 for spring.
- **A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship for the summer?**  
This can not be used for summer semester.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?**  
This does not apply to all on-line programs, continuing education programs or non-residents.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what are the criteria?**  
The student may not renew this scholarship.
- **Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution?**  
This may not be added to other scholarships.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**  
We are an open enrollment, so the student needs to have graduated from High School.
