17 ~~substantially limits one or more major life activities and does not require specialized~~
18 ~~instruction under special education services.~~

19 ~~—— (2) "Brain injury impairment" or "Concussion impairment" means a short term~~
20 ~~disability of the brain caused by an external physical force that substantially limits one or~~
21 ~~more major life activities, and which adversely affects a student's access to the student's~~
22 ~~education.~~

23 ~~—— (3) "Hearing impairment" means a hearing disability that substantially limits one or~~
24 ~~more major life activity, which may require assistive technology but does not require~~
25 ~~specialized instruction under special education services.~~

26 ~~—— (4) "Learning impairment" means a learning disability, which includes, but is not~~
27 ~~limited to, dyslexia, dysgraphia, and dyscalculia, that substantially limits one or more major~~
28 ~~life activities, but does not require specialized instruction under special education services.~~

30 ~~following functions that adversely limit a student's access to the student's education:~~

91 ~~allows individual detailed student records to be exchanged electronically between public~~

94 ~~website utilized by the Board Special Education Services section to collect compliance and~~
