Can a student defer the scholarship?

U.S. Citizen/Permanent Resident
Legal and Current Visa Status (e.g. F1 Academic Visa)
H-1B Visa (e.g. DACA)

Are the scholarships full-tuition?

Yes. Students will need to apply for additional scholarships on the Scholarship page of snow.edu from November 1st- March 1st.

What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?

If students are awarded a scholarship, when will those funds be available to them?

Usually about 1 week before the semester begins.
