

1 **R277. Education, Administration.**

2 **R277-550. Charter Schools - Definitions.**

3 **R277-550-1. Authority and Purpose.**

4 (1) This rule is authorized by:

5 (a) [Utah Constitution Article X, Section 3](#), which vests general control and supervision  
6 over public education in the Board;

7 (b) Subsection [53E-3-401\(4\)](#), which allows the Board to make rules to execute the  
8 Board's duties and responsibilities under the Utah Constitution and state law; and

9 (c) [Title 53G, Chapter 5, Charter Schools](#), which allows the Board to make rules  
10 governing aspects of operations of charter schools.

11 (2) The purpose of this rule is to establish definitions for rules governing charter  
12 schools.

13 (3) The definitions contained in this rule apply to Rules [R277-550 through R277-555](#).

14 **R277-550-2. Definitions.**

15 (1) "Amendment" means a change or addition to a charter agreement.

16 (2) "Authorizer" means an entity approved to authorize the establishment of a charter  
17 school under Sections [53G-5-304](#) through [53G-5-306](#).

18 (3) "Charter school" means a public school created in accordance with the provisions  
19 of [Title 53G, Chapter 5, Charter Schools](#).

20 (4)(a) "Charter school agreement" or "Charter agreement" means a written agreement  
21 between a charter school and its authorizer containing the terms and conditions for the  
22 operation of a charter school.

23 (b) The charter school agreement maintained by a charter school's authorizer is the  
24 final, official, and complete agreement.

25 (5) "Charter school deficiency" means:

26 (a) failure of a charter school to comply with its charter agreement, including  
27 governance, financial, academic, or operational obligations;

28 (b) failure of a charter school to comply with the requirements of state or federal law  
29 or board rule;

30 (c) failure of a charter school to meet terms established by the school's authorizer as  
31 part of a remediation process; or

32 (d) fraud or misuse of funds by charter school governing board members or  
33 employees.

34 (6) "Charter school governing board" means the local board that governs a charter  
35 school.

36 (7) "Expansion" means:

37 (a) an increase in the number of grade levels offered by a charter school identified by  
38 a single school number; or

39 (b) an increase in the number of students for which a charter school identified by a  
40 single school number is authorized to receive funding.

41 (8) "Lease adjusted debt burden ratio" means a school's cumulative annual debt service  
42 payments, inclusive of cumulative annual lease payments, divided by the school's unrestricted  
43 annual operating revenue.

44 ~~(8)9~~ "Mentor" means an individual or organization with expertise or demonstrated  
45 competence, approved by the State Charter School Board to advise charter schools in the  
46 Mentoring Program.

47 ~~(9)10~~ "Mentoring program" means the State Charter School Board mentoring  
48 program.

49 (11) "New school" means any school receiving a new school number, including a new  
50 charter school, or a new satellite school.

51 ~~[(10) "Probation" means a written formal action and notification through which a school~~  
52 ~~is required to demonstrate the school's compliance with the authorizer's probationary~~  
53 ~~requirements.~~

54 ~~———— (11) "Replication school" means a charter school affiliated with an existing charter~~  
55 ~~school physically located in the state of Utah that:~~

56 ~~———— (a) has the same governing board as the existing charter school;~~

58 ~~\_\_\_\_\_ (c) is located at a different site or in a different geographical area than the existing~~

61 (12) "Non-operating charter school" means a charter school that has not received  
62 minimum school program funds or federal funds and is not providing educational services  
63 during a fiscal year, such as a charter school in a start-up period.

64 (13) "Operating charter school" means a charter school that has received minimum  
65 school program funds or federal funds and is providing educational services during a fiscal  
66 year.

67 (14) "Probation" means a written formal action and notification through which a school  
68 is required to demonstrate the school's compliance with the authorizer's probationary  
69 requirements.

70 (1~~4~~<sup>5</sup>) "Satellite school" means a charter school affiliated with an existing charter  
71 school physically located within the state of Utah that:

- 72 (a) has the same governing board as the existing charter school;  
73 (b) ~~[has a]~~ may have a similar or different program of instruction or grades served from  
74 the existing charter school;  
75 (c) is located at a different site or in a different geographical area than the existing  
76 charter school; and  
77 (d) has a separate school number than the existing charter school.

78 (1~~5~~<sup>6</sup>) "School number" means a number assigned by the Superintendent in  
79 accordance with National Center for Education Statistics criteria that identifies a distinct school  
80 within an LEA.

81 (1~~6~~<sup>7</sup>) "State Charter School Board" means the board established in Section [53G-5-](#)  
82 [201](#).

83 (1~~7~~<sup>8</sup>) "Utah Consolidated Application" or "UCA" means the web-based grants  
84 management tool employed by the Superintendent through which LEAs submit plans and  
85 budgets for approval by the Superintendent or Board.

86 (1[8]9) "Utah eTranscript and Record Exchange" or "UTREx" has the same meaning  
87 as described in Subsection [R277-484-2\(11\)](#).
