Associate Educator License (AEL)

- An approved AEL for World Language allows a Licensed Teacher to teach World Language classes while working on the World Language Endorsement—meaning they are not yet qualified in World Language.
- The applicant has three years from the date of the AEL is approved to complete all requirements for the World Language endorsement in the specific language of instruction.
- The applicant must document passing the appropriate Praxis II where available or an OPI or OPIc at an Advanced-Low when the Praxis is not available for the language.

Submitting the Application

- Print and complete this World Language Endorsement Application.
- Attach proof of passing the Praxis II Content Test and Oral Proficiency Test.
- Attach original transcript(s) for methods course with the relevant course **highlighted**.

For Electronic Transcripts: Original Transcripts with courses highlighted is preferred but not necessary. They do not need to be sealed in an envelope, but they need to be originals and on college/university transcript paper. Photocopies of transcripts that you have electronically received will not be accepted. We will accept electronic transcripts only if they are sent directly from the college/university through a transcript clearinghouse to transcripts@schools.utah.gov . Transcripts should be sent before you submit your endorsement application. Please note on the application that transcripts have been sent electronically.

For those who are submitting an Out-of-State (OOS) or Alternative Routes to Licensure (ARL) please attach this completed endorsement form to it.
