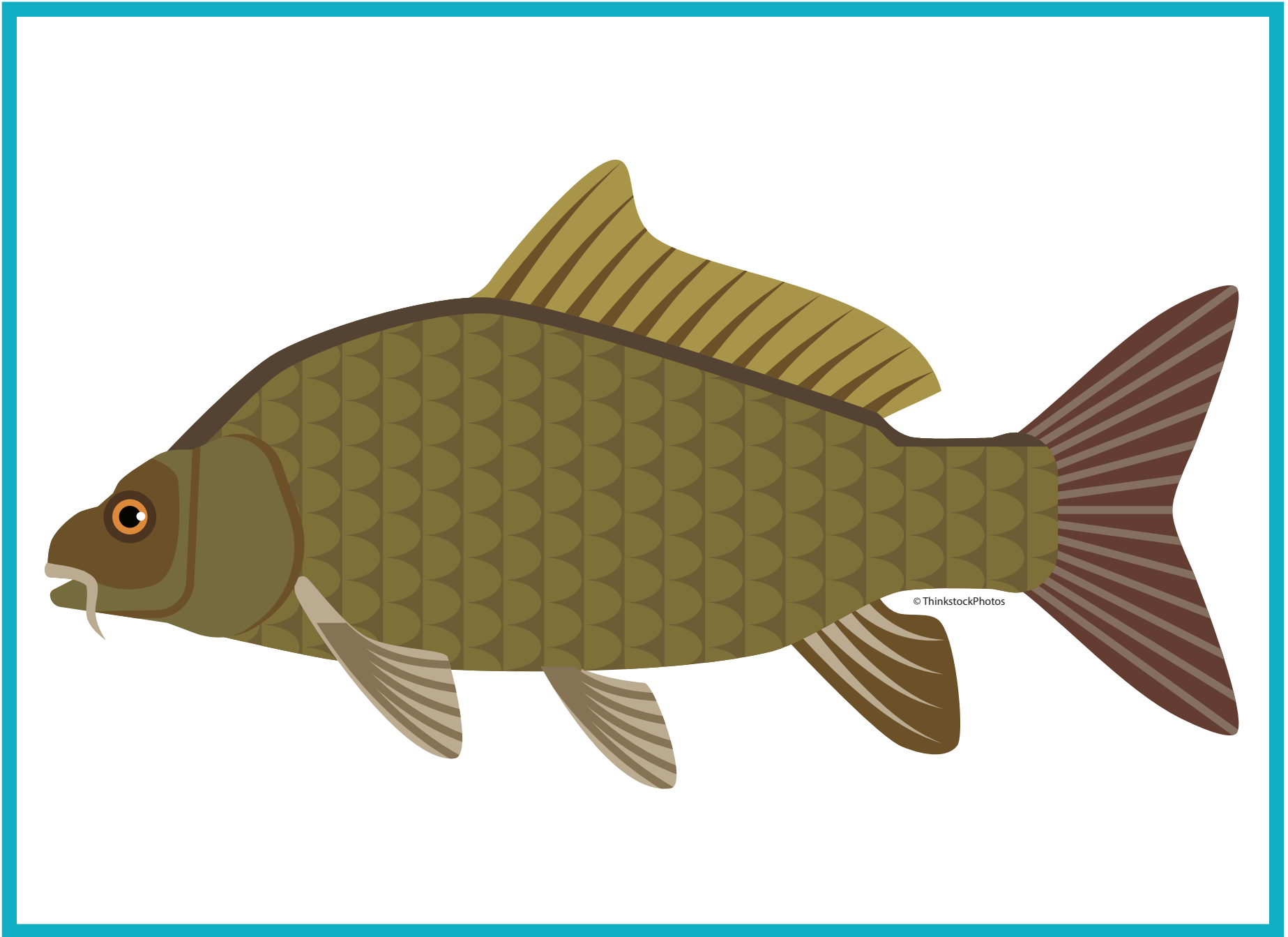

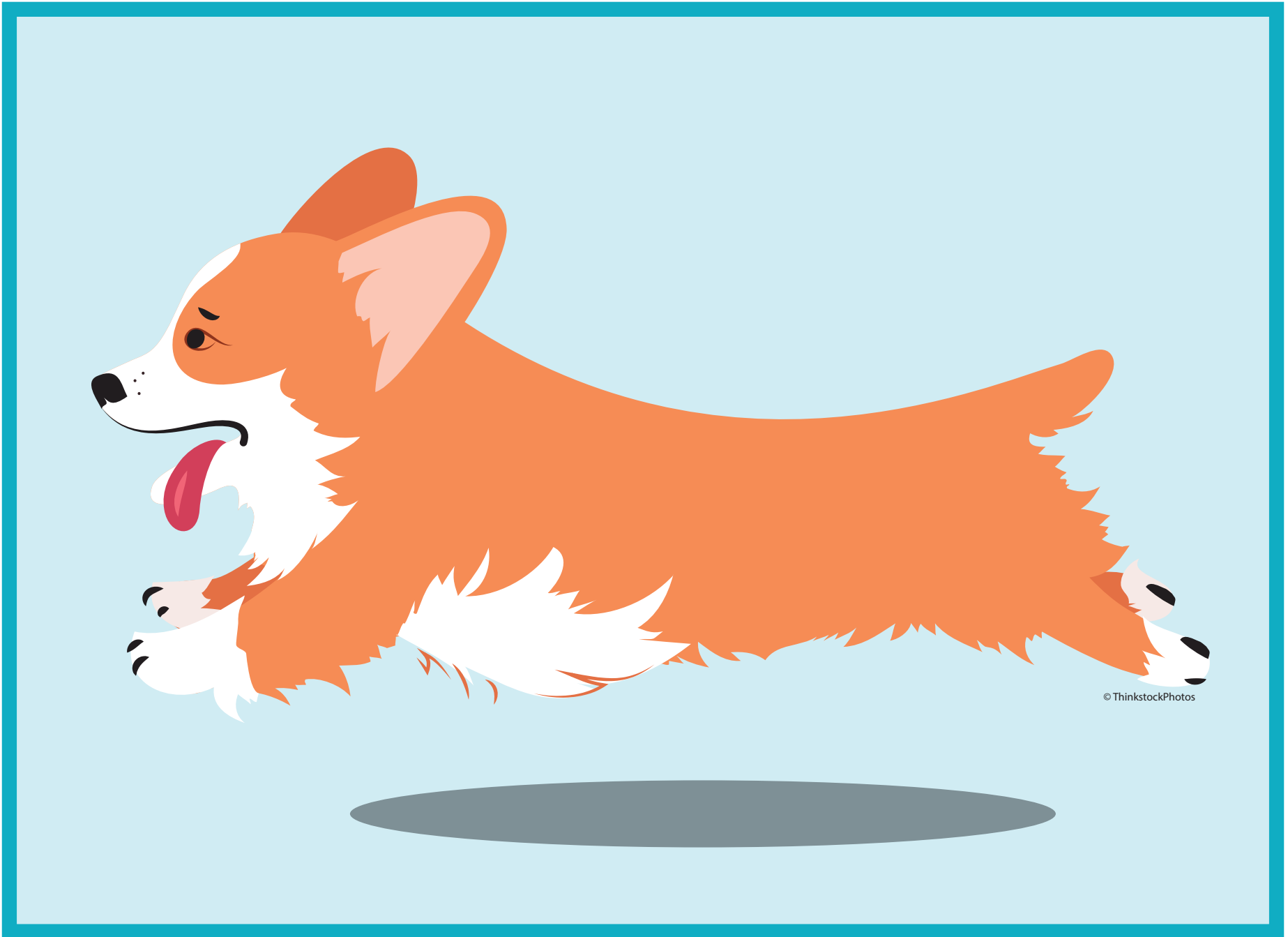

Bats can fly, even at night, but they do not have feathers. Bats are covered with fur.

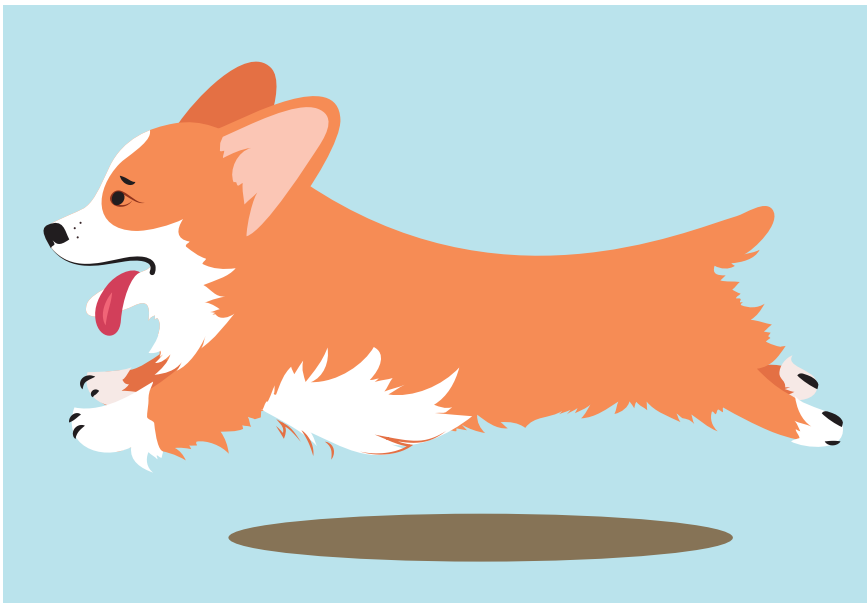
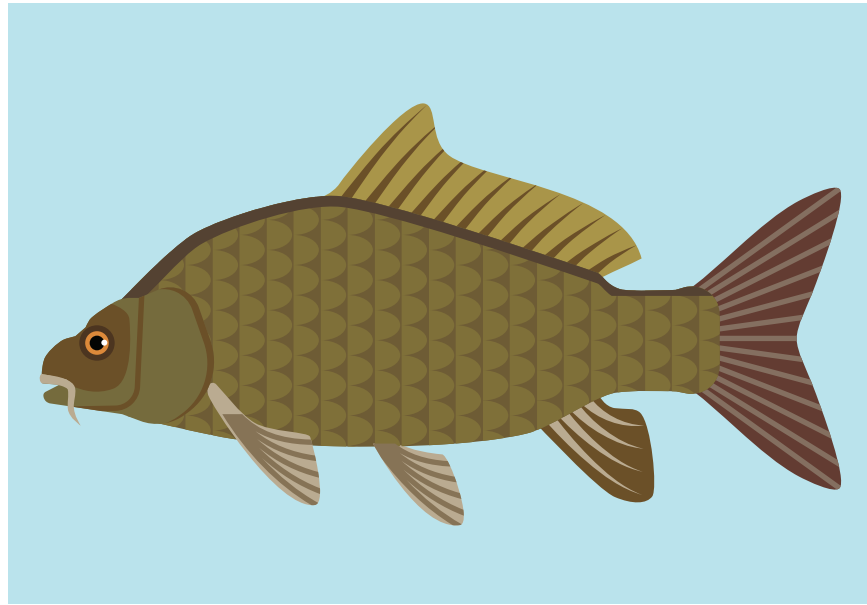
