

Tuition Awards – Institution Criteria

Bridgerland Technology College

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?:** The scholarship waives tuition up to \$1,000. Recipient is responsible for any tuition charges beyond the scope of this scholarship; to pay all fees; to purchase own books, tools and supplies; and for payment of any other cost associated with enrollment.
- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Bridgerland is open-entry and programs are taught year round. Recipient must begin training within one year of high school graduation and tuition may be waived from that time up to \$1,000. Recipient must maintain a minimum of 15-hours per week enrollment. Recipient must maintain standards of attendance, progress, and conduct. Student must adhere to policies and procedures outlined in the College Catalog available on-line at www.btech.edu
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** Many of Bridgerland's certificate programs qualify for this scholarship. Access the Scholarship Eligible Programs list on our school website: <http://btech.edu/students/financial-aid/scholarships/>
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Recipients are expected to begin training at Bridgerland Technical College within one year of graduation from high school. Scholarships commonly may be held for a later start date for students who wish to serve church missions or who may be involved in military service within that year following graduation, and would like to begin training immediately following their service. These students must contact the Financial Aid Office within one year of high school graduation to notify the College of their plans and have the date the student must begin using the scholarship determined.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** This scholarship is not available for renewal or extension. However, other scholarships and sources of financial aid are available and students are encouraged to apply. Current opportunities are posted online at www.btech.edu
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Bridgerland does not “rank” new students as freshman. Bridgerland offers competency based training in a generally open-entry/open exit individualized learning and teaching model. Admissions for the CTE scholarship recipient require students have a high school diploma from within the state of Utah, and complete the College assessment or provide documentation of acceptable ACT (17) or SAT (1210) scores. Davis Applied Technology College

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?** \$1500 toward tuition and student fees, additional program fees may apply.
- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Davis Tech is an open enrollment institution. Scholarships are valid for the current fiscal year July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** Math only and continuing education courses are not eligible.
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Scholarships are valid for the current fiscal year July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** CTE scholarships are not renewable, however other scholarships are available.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Admission requirements vary by program. Students must maintain half-time schedule.

Dixie State University

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?** Yes, Full Tuition
- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** No, can only start using it in fall 2018.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?:** ESL, Communication Organizational Leadership, Degree Completion Program, Institute for Continued Learning, Peace Officer Standards Training, and Road Scholars Courses
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** This scholarship is not deferrable.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No, it is not renewable.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Admitted to DSU, maintain full-time enrollment and a 2.0 GPA.

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?:**
Yes, full tuition
- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?:** Students may access scholarships in the summer if a program starts in the summer. Program start dates vary throughout the year.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?:** All certificate programs are available for recipients.
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?:** Submit a letter of deferral to the Vice President of Student Services explaining the reason for the deferral and the length of deferral. This will be reviewed by the Vice President of Student Services and the response of granted, denied, or require further information to be granted of the request will be made.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** The scholarship is valid through completion of the program.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Open admission, students must take and pass college placement test (CPT) as required by specific programs. All other admission requirements vary by program.

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Yes, it can be used in the summer.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** Programs that are less than 300 hours such as Real Estate, Driver Education Math-only classes, Certified Nursing Assistant, Clinical Lab Assistant, Online Classes.
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Students must activate the scholarship by October 31 of the year they graduate. No deferment available.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Every program has a testing level the student must pass.

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** No, all Snow College Scholarships are applicable for fall and spring only.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** Yes, Humanities Division, Fine Arts & Communication, Biological Sciences, Mathematics Department, Social and Behavioral Science
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Students are permitted to defer academic scholarships if it pertains to military, medical, and church service. Any other scholarship that does not fit into this category may not be deferred.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No, however we have many different scholarships to offer and Snow can help you apply for outside scholarships.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** We are an inclusive school that provides open enrollment to our student population. Admitted students must have graduated with a high school diploma and have taken the ATC/SAT.

- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** None, but we ask that the student contact the college as soon as the scholarship is awarded so we can discuss the students plans, how the scholarship works, and plan out his/her educational experience with us!

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Tooele Tech is open year round. Students can apply at any time.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** All programs are available.
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Students need to enroll within one year following their graduation date.

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Yes.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** Post Academy
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** The student must be enrolled with in one calendar year of the award date.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No, the scholarship is not renewable.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** Program entrance requirements vary. Incoming students are required to take placement tests or provide ACT scores.

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** Yes.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** The tuition award is for any CTE or STEM based certificate or degree.
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** Student must complete a leave of absence form for USU Moab.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No, the scholarship is not renewable.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** A student must submit ACT test scores, high school transcript and have a 2.33 GPA to apply and a 2.67 GPA to renew.

Utah Valley University

- **Are the scholarships full-tuition? If not, what is the dollar amount?** One year full tuition (student and course fees are not included).
- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** This scholarship cannot be used in the summer.
- **Are there any programs/majors at your institution that this scholarship does not apply toward?** ESL, Global Aviation, Fire Fighting, EMS and Police Academy
- **What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?** The student will need to complete a Request to Hold Form and provide documentation as to the reason they are placing the scholarship on hold. We place scholarships on hold for mission, military, medical and humanitarian services for 2 years.
- **Can a student in good standing renew the scholarship for a second year? If yes, what is the criteria?** No. It is a one-year scholarship award.
- **What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?** There is a GPA requirement but must have also taken the ACT/SAT.

- **A one year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the fall and end in the spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?** No, scholarship is only for fall and spring semesters.
