

CARES Act P.L. 116-136

- **Elementary Secondary Schools Emergency Relief (ESSER)**

- \$67,821,787
- 90% allocated to LEAs based on 2019 Title I, Part A percentage of funds
- 10% reserved for USBE
 - Base awards for LEAs that do not receive Title I funds or received less than \$21,000 from 90% ESSER funds
 - PPE, wipes, hand sanitizer purchases for LEAs and schools

- **Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER)**

- \$29,189,663
- Focus on students who are at risk and students with disabilities

- **Equitable Services provisions under both ESSER and GEER**

- CARES Act says provide in “same manner as Section 1117 of ESEA/ESSA”
- U.S. ED's Interim Final Rule (IFR) had force of law – July 1
- NAACP v DeVos – September 4 = IFR vacated and no longer in effect revert back to Sec. 1117
