

# TH Bell Applicant FAQ for USBE

- **When will I know if I'm awarded?**
  - Our office will notify you by email before **May 18th, 2019**
- **Will I be notified if I am not awarded?**
  - Yes, our office notifies all applicants.
- **Can I list more than one Higher Education Institution on the application?**
  - Yes. This does not affect consideration when we review applications.
- **I have graduated from high school, but I am interested in applying for the TH Bell Program. What can I do?**
  - Contact the College or University you are attending. Each Institution takes applications for the TH Bell. Please see the list of [contacts here](#) for the Higher Ed Institutions.
- **Do I need to include the ACT/SAT Report? Can I just include my transcripts that have my scores on them?**
  - Unfortunately, we review your entire ACT report for information that is not presented in the score alone. To see examples of acceptable reports, please see our list under "Acceptable Documents"
- **Do I need to include a resume? I have not had a job.**
  - Yes, please! Since this program is centered around a career, we'd like to see a resume in case a teaching related experience wasn't included in your application.
- **Do I need to include letters of recommendation?**
  - You can include them if you wish, but they are not required, and will not be reviewed by the committee.
- **Why do I need to put my social security number on the application?**
  - Since this program is set up as a student loan that will be forgiven, your social security number is necessary.
