

Assurances: This agreement is in effect only when the following criteria and conditions of the Career Pathways Program and Student have been met:

- A. Students will be accepted into the postsecondary portion of the program according to application criteria.
- B. LDS Business College accepts the transfer of articulated secondary level CTE credits awarded to high school students when the following criteria is met:
 - 1 = Completion of CTE course
 - 2 = Score 80% or above on the skills certification test and the class performance objectives
 - 3 = Course must have been taken within the last 4 years
- C. Compliance with approved Board policies.
- D. This credit will be offered as competency based test credit in cases where the student does not enroll in the class for concurrent enrollment. The College already accepts concurrent enrollment credit where applicable when the college transcript is received.
