
2016-17 CTE CAREER PATHWAYS

56% of students concentrated in a CTE Career Pathway. A **CONCENTRATOR** is a student who has completed 1.5 credits in a single CTE program of study.




25% of students completed a CTE Career Pathway. A **COMPLETER** is a student who has completed 3.0 credits in a single CTE program of study.
