
Qualification Level Distribution by Educator Assignment



Student Teacher Stipends

- <u>HB 221 (2024) Stipends for Future Educators</u>
- \$8,400,000 Appropriation
- \$6,000 for a student teacher:
 - Attending a Utah college/university
 - Completing clinical experience in Utah LEA
- More than 1300 applied (July 2024 January 2025)



Stipends' Impact: In their own words "The stipend helped me focus 100% on my student teaching." "The stipend relieved a lot of my stress and it made me feel more valuable as a teacher." "It kept me healthy...I could buy the groceries [my family] needed." "The stipend sent a tangible message that the state values my public service." "Without it, I truly do not know how we would have gotten by."
