Annual CACTUS Training for LEAs

The Educator Licensing team will be offering Annual CACTUS Training for school districts and charter schools on *Monday, August 4, 2025, 2-3:30pm.* The training will be online in a webinar format and recorded. USIMS (Utah Schools Information Management System) ACCOUNT!

Every educator who is working in Utah must have a <u>USIMS</u> account by October 13th. Otherwise, LEAs will not be able to manage their employees once CACTUS goes offline. Many people who have educator licenses in Utah with an expiration date of 2026 and 2027 have not created USIMS accounts.

As your LEA is developing policies for Supplement for Highly Needed Educators (SHiNE), please contact Malia Hite with any questions. SHiNE is only available for teachers. Student Data Privacy

Recent legislation changed the Student Data Privacy training requirement to make it an annual training. Board rule R277-487 was recently updated to remove the training as a license renewal requirement. Starting July 2025, the Student Data Privacy training will no longer be required for license renewal. School Leadership University Recommendations

Recent updates to USIMS now require educators to accept the recommendation in USIMS before the license area is added to the license. If they do not complete the license process in USIMS, the School Leadership license area will not be awarded. Educators will be notified by email when the recommendation is submitted by the university. For more information, please contact Malia Hite.

Educator Salary Adjustments & Unsatisfactory Evaluations

Changes to the Educator Salary Adjustment (ESA) program (<u>53F-2-405</u>) disqualify educators who have three consecutive "unsatisfactory" annual educator evaluations. If your LEA has an employee that has three consecutive "unsatisfactory" annual evaluations, please notify the USBE Financial Ops so we can adjust the LEA's ESA allocation.
