### Timeline

September 16, 2024: Application released in Utah Grants

October 16, 2024: Utah Grants Application Deadline

November 18, 2024: Award Notification

- All funds will be awarded through the Utah Grants Management System
- Funds must be spent by <u>June 30, 2026</u>
- "Carry forward" will not be approved\*

August 1, 20

End-of-year reports due to USBE

\*Funds must be relinquished if not spent by the deadline (June 30, 2026)



# Suicide Prevention Funding Changes

For FY25, due to reduced funding, suicide prevention funds will <u>not</u> be distributed through direct-flow/lump sum and <u>must</u> be requested through the Prevention Block Grant application.



# Requesting Suicide Prevention Funds

- \$502,000.00 will be available to distribute.
- After a needs assessment in your LEA, determine how many schools will need \$1,000/school for suicide prevention programming (For FY25 only)
- Designate the number of schools you will be applying for on your application.



## Positive Behaviors Plan Funding

All LEAs will receive \$4,000 **Positive Behaviors Plan** (ECSN) funding through lump sum/direct flow-through funds.

- \$1,000 per school to implement the positive behaviors plan
- \$3,000 as a stipend for the positive behaviors plan specialist (per school)
  - \$700 of the \$3,000 may be used for benefits



## **Overview:** Prevention Block Grant Funding for Prevention Programs <u>53F-2-525</u>, <u>R277-439</u>

During the 2023 General Legislative Session, House Bill (H.B.) 16 - Block Grant Funding for Prevention Programs in Public Education was passed allowing LEAs to braid grant funding attached to the following sections of Code:

- 53G-9-702 Suicide Prevention
- 53G-10-407 Positive Behaviors Plan Positive Behavior Specialist Stipend
- 53E-3-522 Substance Abuse Prevention

H.B. 16 (2023) also allows USBE to distribute excess funds in the <u>Underage</u> <u>Drinking and Substance Abuse Prevention Program Restricted Account</u> to LEAs through the prevention block grant. These funds are only available through the Block Grant.




# Funding Available (Choose one grant)

- Prevention Block Grant: ~\$3.2 million
- Substance Use Prevention Grant: ~\$120,000

This looks like

- One prevention grant application
- The ability for LEAs to opt in
- Streamlined/reduced reporting requirements

Combined funding would allow LEAs to pursue implementing evidence-based practices for more students (such as mentoring)

Improved implementation and evaluation of programs



## Why

- Decrease siloed approaches
- Braided funds can have a greater impact
- Allow LEAs to implement programs to address the needs of their student population
- Streamline and reduce work and reporting requirements
- Facilitates <u>upstream</u> prevention efforts and innovation



## Comprehensive Prevention Plan

**Definition:** Implements evidence-based early intervention and prevention practices tailored to achieve outcomes and mitigate risk factors in a manner consistent with:

- Substance abuse prevention programs
- Suicide prevention programs
- Positive behavior plans
- Includes information on the impact of childhood trauma on student learning, including information advising educators against practicing medicine, giving a diagnosis, or providing treatment
- Includes resiliency-building skills
- Designed in collaboration with USBE and with input from parents, students, educators, and support staff



#### Allowable use of Funds-Tier 1 & Tier 2

#### Awarded funds may be used for the following:

- Prevention-focused parent seminars
- To supplement specific prevention needs identified by the LEA and that can be justified through data
- Other evidence-based prevention practices authorized by USBE
- Prevention-based Professional Learning
- Supplies and materials related to implementing prevention programs



### Unallowable use of Funds Administrative Board Rule R277-439-4

- Gang Prevention Programs\*
- Food
- Capital improvements
- Metal detectors
- Vape detectors
- School safety initiatives
- Treatment
