First Consideration for Academic Areas

- Math
- Science
- English/Language Arts
- Graduation Rate Increase (Secondary Schools ONLY)
- College and Career Readiness (Secondary Schools ONLY)

Academic Area Selection

- Concise and only addresses the priority need.
- Each academic area selected in the goal section must also include a measurement OR do not select that area.











Reminders

- The School LAND Trust Plan SUPPORTS the Teacher and Student Success Plan and the LEA Academic Priorities.
- Do not include identifiable student or personal data.
- Do a spelling and grammar check before submission (these plans become public record).

Goals should be SMART

S tudent-centered, specific, stated in positive terms

M easurable

A cademic, achievable

R elevant

Time-limited



Measurement

- Written in a way that allows schools to see if progress is made.
- Limit data sources to meaningful tools.



Action Plan Steps

- Specific
- Active
- Written in future-tense
- Clear on how the steps support the goal
- Written with the fund amount in parentheses

Expenditures

- Each expenditure must be included in an action plan step.
- **DO NOT** include any new information
- DO reference the action plan step number OR copy and paste the action plan step
