## School-based Mental Health Screening Grant

### Screening Tool LEA Request Form Application

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[State Statute 53F-2-522](#) and [R277-625](#) sets standards for local education agencies (LEAs) to implement approved mental health screening programs for students. If the LEA chooses to apply for use of a mental health screener that is not on the pre-approved list, the LEA shall submit an application in a form prescribed by the Superintendent specifying: The Superintendent shall review the application in consultation with the Division and approve or deny the application within 30 days of receipt. If the application is approved, the Superintendent shall submit the approved application to the Board for final approval.

2. Mental Health Screening or Screener: *means a systematic tool or process: (a) to identify if a student is experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing, issues related to the student's mental health; (b) for an early identification strategy to detect the onset of*

*mental health conditions, enabling the mental health conditions to be potentially addressed; and (c) that is not: (i) a diagnostic tool or process; or (ii) a system or process used by a student's teacher to observe behavior for the purpose of targeted learning interventions.*
