R277. Education, Administration.

R277-931. Required Provision of Period Products in Schools.

R277-931-1. Authority and Purpose.

(1) This rule is authorized by:

(a) Utah Constitution Article X, Section 3, which vests general control and

supervision of public education in the Board;

(b) Subsection 53E-3-401(4), which allows the Board to make rules to execute

the Board's duties and responsibilities under the Utah Constitution and state law; and

(c) Subsections 53G-4-413(4) and 53G-5-414(4), which require the Board to

oversee the implementation of the requirements of LEAs providing period products in

schools.

(2) The purpose of this rule is to clarify which female or unisex restrooms LEAs

are required to install dispensers in to provide period products to students.

R277-931-2. Required Provision of Period Products in Certain Elementary School

Settings.

For purposes of the requirements of Sections 53G-4-413 and 53G-5-414, "each

female or unisex restroom within an elementary school facility" does not include a

female or unisex restroom used exclusively by students in Kindergarten or younger.
