



## A Dashboard Is Coming!

- (4) No later than January 31, 2026, the state board shall create a communication dashboard for the program and only related to eligible students enrolled in a public school that may include:
  - (a) a counselor contact list for an eligible student that is accessible to an authorized online course provider; and
  - (b) progress monitoring fields that are accessible to the primary LEA, the eligible student's counselor, and the eligible student's parent containing:
    - (i) grade progress reporting of an eligible student by an authorized online course provider;
  - (ii) an ability to flag a student that is at-risk of failing an online course; and
    - (iii) other relevant capabilities the state board determines to be necessary in consultation with LEA users of the dashboard.



## The Main Statuses

- 1. Pending Execution
- 1.1 Waiting for approval/acceptance from LEA/USBE and the Provider.

- 2. Enrollment Complete
  - 2.1 Student has gained access to the course.
- 2.2 The 20 business days before half of the funding is dispersed begins.



#### 3. Confirmed

- 3.1 20 business days have passed, and half of the funding is dispersed.
  - 3.2 Student has started working on the course.
- 3. 3 If a student has not been actively working on the course, they may be dropped from the course by the online provider.

#### 4. Pass All Complete

4.1 All agreed credit completed with passing grades by June 30th

Provider certifies student is actively working in course

Earned .25 additional credit in progress

Provider may update status if one of the situations below aligns with the student's progress.




