



## Statewide Online Education Program (SOEP) and Concurrent Enrollment (CE) Course Credit Guidance Document

- The <u>2025-2026 USHE General Education Navigator</u> specifies the credit amount for each (CE) course as it fulfills high school graduation requirements
- CE course credit values offered through the SOEP will align with the credit values listed on the USHE General Education Navigator document
- Credits in your SIS must align with the credits in SEATS. Below are the credit amounts for CE and the SOEP that align with the USHE General Education Navigator
  - o **ENGL 1010, 2010, 2200** 1.0 credit
  - MATH 1010, 1030, 1050 1.0 credit
  - o **BIO 1010, CHEM 1010, PHYS 1010** 1.0 credit
    - Please indicate if a course is SEEd or not
  - **Human Development** .5 credit
  - o **HIST 1500** .5 credit
  - o **HIST 1510** .5 credit
  - o **HIST 1700** .5 credit
  - HIST 1700 year-long 1.0 credit
  - o **PSYC** 1010 .5 credit
  - o **ART** 1010 1.0 credit
  - o All CTE courses .5 credit
    - All CTE courses in high school are to be .5 credit hours. Utah graduation requirements state students are to take at least two .5 credit CTE courses.
  - o Financial Literacy .5 credit
  - All elective courses .5 credit
