


Provider Website Specifications

Setting Up the Provider Website for Success

Provider materials linked to the Statewide Online Education Program are required to meet the following standards:

- 1. The website may be in any accepted format, such as **PDF** or **HTML**.
- 2. The website must meet <u>WCAG accessibility standards</u> to make sure content is accessible to persons with disabilities and those who may be using assistive technology.
- 3. The provider name must appear on the website as the main header.
- 4. Name on the website must reflect the same name on file with USBE.
- **5.** Sub-headers can include other trademarks or trade names if the provider has permission to use them on the webpage.



- **5.** A link to the course catalog on a different website is not acceptable. However, it is okay if the course catalog can be expanded or revealed within the same site. *For example, a category with a plus sign that shows the courses and their descriptions when clicked is acceptable.*
- 6. The course catalog must **only** include courses that will be offered to SOEP.
 - No classes should be offered that cannot be offered to every student in grades 6-12, in the State of Utah.
 - Each course must have an approved **USBE Core Code** next to each course.
- **7.** Additional information on the program, school or enrollment may be on the webpage. All information must be specific to participation in the Statewide Online Education Program.
- 8. Contact information for the provider's online program must appear on the webpage.
