Outcomes Data Timeline



Indicator 7 Preschool Outcomes is part of the data states report annually to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) through the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR). This indicator is focused on the percent of students ages 3–5 with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) and utilizes Utah Preschool Outcome Data (UPOD) to measure three outcome areas:

- A. Positive social-emotional skills (including social relationships)
- B. Acquisition and use of knowledge and skills (including early language/communication and early literacy)
- C. Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs

Year round



Local education agencies (LEAs) input data into UPOD on the Utah Program Improvement Planning System (UPIPS) within 30 days of a student entering or exiting a Utah preschool special education program.

August 15



The Utah State Board of Education (USBE) Special Education Preschool Specialist begins to send reminders to input and finalize all UPOD scores from the previous school year before the cutoff date of September 1.

September 1



USBE Preschool Specialist locks data from the previous school year and runs state report.



October - January

USBE specialists confirm and analyze data.



February

Data is submitted to OSEP via the SPP/APR.



Spring

LEAs are given finalized data to analyze.
