

Collaborating With Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Liaisons

STEPS FOR EDUCATORS/SCHOOL PERSONNEL



Introduction

Effective collaboration between educators and vocational rehabilitation (VR) is essential to providing comprehensive support to students with disabilities. This step-by-step guide outlines a structured process to facilitate such collaboration, ensuring that students receive the necessary services and resources to achieve their postsecondary educational and employment goals.

Step-by-Step Process

1 Initial Meeting and Relationship Building

- 1. <u>Identify your VR Counselor liaison:</u>
- 2. Identify your Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) Instructor liaison
- 3. Identify Pre-ETS Contract Providers in your area:
- 4. Schedule an initial meeting between the special educator and VR.
- 5. Communicate logistics with your liaison (Wi-Fi, parking, check in protocol, meeting space)
- 6. Discuss each professional's role, responsibilities, and services provided
- 7. Establish open lines of communication and agree on preferred methods of contact (e.g., email, phone, in-person meetings)
- 8. Set goals for the collaboration, focusing on the needs of the students

2 Student Assessment and Information Sharing

- 1. Identify students who could benefit from VR/Pre-ETS services. Students to consider:
 - Those having an IEP/504 Plan/Disability
 - Aged 14-22
 - Those with a desire to participate in VR/Pre-ETS

- 2. Gather relevant information to help the VR/Pre-ETS liaison determine eligibility for services (i.e. copy of IEP, 504, medical records, completed Pre-ETS Participation Form-USOR form 79)
- 3. Share relevant student information with the VR liaison to help with vocational planning (IEP, postsecondary transition assessments, postsecondary transition plans) ensuring confidentiality and adherence to privacy laws.

3 Alignment of Postsecondary Planning

- 1. Discuss and coordinate individual student goals and services
- 2. Identify gaps in postsecondary transition services for students
- 3. Identify who delivers instruction/services to help students reach their goals
- 4. Schedule regular check-ins to monitor student progress, celebrate achievements and evaluate the overall success of collaborative efforts

Possible VR Ligisons Include:

- <u>VR Counselors</u> assist students with the transition from school to work and can assist eligible students with the full individualized set of services VR can offer.
- <u>Pre-ETS Instructors</u> offer classroom instruction called job readiness workshops on the 5 Pre-ETS and collaborate with VR Counselors to provide 1-1 Pre-ETS for eligible students.
- <u>Pre-ETS Providers/Contractors</u> serve students for a short period of time and provide targeted Pre-ETS through a contract with VR.
