The focus of the Mandt System® is on building healthy relationships between all the stakeholders in human service settings in order to facilitate the development of an organizational culture that provides the emotional, psychological, and physical safety needed in order to teach new behaviors to replace the behaviors that are labeled "challenging".

MIDAS Registration is **REQUIRED** to attend the re-certification course. Each re-certification training section has a maximum of 10 participants. TO REGISTER FOR A RE-CERTIFICATION COURSE, YOU MUST HOLD A CURRENT CERTIFICATION IN THE MANDT SYSTEM, WHICH MEANS YOU HAVE BEEN TRAINED AND CERTIFIED WITHIN THE PAST YEAR. If this is not the case, enroll in a new certification course. Re-licensure points are available.
