C&C ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

USBE EXPECTATIONS FOR LEAS

The following describes the expectations USBE has for Local Education Agencies (LEA) when implementing the <u>Check & Connect Mentor Program</u>. These expectations are outlined as the responsibilities each role has in implementing the C&C program with fidelity statewide.

PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS AND COORDINATORS

- Determine need and scope of use
 - Develop local understanding of C&C

- Introduce C&C to key school personnel such as principals, counselors, etc.
- Monitor fidelity of implementation
- Hire dedicated C&C mentors
 - Provide mentor support and supervision, including regular local professional learning
- Manage "Check" data access and reporting, including local use of outcome data
- Coordinate quarterly submission of C&C Mentor Caseload Summary to USBE for all trained C&C Mentors

CHECK & CONNECT TRAINED STAFF

- Collect weekly "Check" data of assigned students on:
 - Attendance
 - Behavior
 - Course performance
- Meet with assigned students weekly for "Connect" meetings
- Implement family engagement, including regular "Check" updates
- Report end of quarter "Check" data to USBE
